Tuesday, January 19, 2016

Pursuant to the law, the board met in Regular Session at 1:00 pm on the 1st floor of the courthouse with Chairman Bill Pohl calling meeting to order with Commissioners Eric Noll and Commissioner Jeff Schuele present for the meeting, County Clerk Pauline M Lee recorded the minutes with County Counselor Pat Henderson present.

Board recited the pledge of allegiance at the start of the meeting.

Minutes of January 12, 2016 were reviewed, Commissioner Noll made the motion to approve the minutes as presented with Commissioner Schuele second and Chairman Pohl calling for a vote, all voted aye, motion carried, 3-0.

Committee Reports: Commissioner Noll said he didn't get to go to the Joint Communication board meeting, he did get to go to NEK CAP last Thursday and also the NEKES meeting in Troy. Chairman Pohl said he attended the Project Concern meeting, new bus should be in any day and they also discussed about replacing another van.

Pat Henderson, County Counselor talked to the board about court appointed attorneys for 2016, instead of four contracts they will have five this year, Bob Campbell who is a court appointed attorney is now City attorney so they need to have another attorney to take the cases that involve the city police, Pat also told the board that they need to discuss increasing the amount that the attorneys get, since there has not been any price increase for three years. The court appoint contracts are for the following attorneys are Kelly Fuemmeler, Robert Campbell, John Kurth, J David Farris and Rex Lane, Commissioner Schuele made the motion to approve the 2016 Court Appointed Attorney contracts and to have Chairman Pohl sign in behalf of the county, Commissioner Noll second with Chairman Pohl calling for a vote, all voted aye, motion carried, 3-0.

Pat Henderson, County Counselor also presented to the board the contract to purchase the property from Mary Rodewald for ROW purposes for a bridge on Sherman and 266th Road at a cost of \$9,000, total acreage is 2.7 acres, Commissioner Noll made a motion to approve the purchase and to have Chairman Pohl sign in behalf of the county for the property in the amount of \$9,000 and that delinquent taxes estimated at \$919 will come out of what the county will be paying for the land and remainder will go to the property owner, Commissioner Schuele second the motion with Chairman Pohl called for a vote, all voted aye, motion carried, 3-0.

Board discussed with Pat Henderson, County Counselor about regular tax sales and what would be involved in doing it.

Michael Wilburn and Austin Martin with Martin Trash and Construction appeared before the board, Mr. Wilburn told the board that they purchased the Bromley Quarry and looking at rubble reprocessing and asked the county about getting a conditional use permit from the county to suffice KDHE requirements, Pat Henderson, County Counselor said that the county is not zoned and would not need a conditional use permit, he will write a letter to that effect and get it to him. Mr. Wilburn also talked to the commission about C&D disposal, did not want to compete with

the county, but if the county is looking at closing theirs, if they would be willing to write a letter to KDHE in favor of Martin Trash doing the C&D disposal, they are looking at somewhere in 2018. Chairman Pohl said he would like to close the county's down if Martin's would get a C&D landfill, that his opinion. Mr. Wilburn also said that they are going to do limestone reprocessing and also tire repurposing. Mr. Wilburn said it will take a while to get everything going. Pat Henderson, County Counselor said he would get letter out to Mr. Wilburn on zoning.

Seth Howard, Road and Bridge Superintendent appeared with a purchase order on restocking metal culverts, they have several quotes, like the culverts made out of aluminum, they last longer, Commissioner Noll made the motion to approve the purchase order in the amount of \$50,193.00 for sixty tubes to restock the county culverts, Commissioner Schuele second with Chairman Pohl calling for a vote, all voted aye, motion carried, 3-0.

Seth talked to the board about a contract or agreement with KDOT on a detour around the Effingham Area that KDOT will be furnishing rock and also doing a video recording of 286th road, Pat Henderson, County Counselor will look over the agreement before board signs.

Seth told the board that he was trying out a traffic counter from Jefferson County on 266th road, if it is something he thinks they can use he would look into cost of one.

Board approved adds and abatements on personal property, real estate and special assessment.

Pauline Lee, County Clerk presented to the board Order 2016-1 to dispose of old purchase orders CAMA flat files, old personal property certifications, 2003 computer generated monthly budget reports, old W-2s from 1958 thru 1990, Commissioner Noll made the motion to approve Order 2016-1 to dispose of old records in the county clerk's office by shredding by Achievement Services, Commissioner Schuele second with Chairman Pohl calling for a vote, all voted aye, motion carried.

Board received a response from the Leavenworth County Commission on a letter that they wrote to them on December 29th, Leavenworth County said that Sean Crittendon said that payment for the second quarter was sent to Atchison County in December and cleared on December 18th in the amount of \$15,489.69, Sean also told them that he could absorb half of the \$28,441.94 without affecting his programs in the last half of SFY2016, Leavenworth County wanted to know how Atchison County will absorb theirs, and they advised Sean to keep both commissions informed of any future payments received by DOC.

Board discussed the giving out of voter registration lists to the political parties, present is one per political party per year, Commissioner Schuele made a motion to change how they are distributed to one printed copy and one digital copy per year to each of the political parties at no cost, Commissioner Noll second with Chairman Pohl calling for a vote, all voted aye, motion carried, 3-0.

Bills for departments were approved for the week.

Commissioner Schuele made a motion to adjourn at 3:05 pm with Commissioner Noll second and Chairman Pohl calling for a vote, all voted aye, motion carried, 3-0.
