Tuesday, July 12, 2016

Pursuant to the law the board met in Regular Session at 1:00 pm with Chairman Bill Pohl calling the meeting to order along with Commissioner Eric Noll present. Commissioner Jeff Schuele absent from the meeting. County Clerk Pauline M Lee, recorded the minutes with County Counselor Pat Henderson present for meeting

Board recited the pledge of allegiance before the meeting.

Minutes of July 5th were reviewed, Commissioner Noll made a motion to approve as read with Chairman Pohl second and called for a vote, both voted aye, motion carried, 2-0, Commissioner Schuele absent.

Committee reports: Chairman Pohl said that he has a JCAB meeting tomorrow, July 13th. Commissioner Noll said he had a NEKCAP meeting on Thursday and a NEKES Thursday morning, and would be attending the Nortonville City council meeting tonight, he was asked if he would attend.

New Business: Commissioner Noll said he was asked by NEK CAP if the county would have a place to post about NEK CAP taking enroll applications for kids, Eric said he talked to Wes about putting it on web site, will wait until Commissioner Schuele is back before deciding.

Seth Howard, Road and Bridge Superintendent appeared on the 2018 off system bridge, the bridge that the commissioners decided last week he talked with Dave from Schwab Eaton and the state suggested not doing that one but pick another. He has some four in the western part of county, Board said that they would like to look at them before deciding, Seth said that he needed to know so that he could get it started, one bridge is near Muscotah and three others are in the Center/Mt Pleasant area, Board asked Seth to go out and take a look at the four ad that they would go along with his choice, Commissioner Noll made the motion to have Seth Howard, Road and Bridge Superintendent look over and decide which bridge would be a good bride for the off system 2018 replace, Chairman Pohl second and called for a vote, both voted aye, motion carried, 2-0, Commissioner Schuele absent

Chairman Pohl told Seth that he would like to see some kind of criteria on choosing things like bridge replacement, some things he would like would be low traffic count, bus route, mail route, etc.

Seth told the board that he had another employee resign to take a different job. Will be placing an ad to replace them.

Chairman Pohl told Seth that Bob Penning would be calling him about getting a tube for an entrance.

Board signed payroll for the week

Bills for the week were approved.

Board received a letter from Leavenworth County concerning adding Shelly Nelson as the Co Administrative Contact with Lucas Schmalbeck, they know that communication between the two counties needs to be ongoing, they are advising Lucas to maintain regular and continuous communication with Shelly.

Board approved partial invoice for Reese & Novelty CPA in the amount of \$5,500.00.

Next Tuesday morning, July 19th Solid Waste Committee will be meeting in the Commission Room to discuss tarping of vehicles and would like to have Sheriff Laurie at the meeting and also would like to discuss the glass container.

Pat Henderson, County Counselor told the board that the courts approved tax sale and they can proceed with the deeds.

Commissioner Noll made a motion to adjourn at 2:10 pm with Chairman Pohl second and called for a vote, both voted aye, motion carried, 2-0, Commissioner Schuele absent.
