Tuesday, May 10, 2022

Pursuant to the law, the Atchison County Commission Board met in Regular Session at 1:00 PM at the Atchison County Courthouse, Lower Level, 423 N 5th St., Atchison, KS. A link to the meeting was made available to the public prior to the meeting. In addition, public attendance was available for the Commission meeting at the Atchison County Courthouse, Lower Level, 423 N 5th St., Atchison, KS. Chairman Eric Noll called the meeting to order with Commissioner Casey Quinn, Commissioner Jack Bower, and County Counselor Patrick Henderson present for the meeting. Kalee Vanderweide, Deputy County Election Officer, recorded the minutes.

The Board recited the pledge of allegiance to start the meeting.

***Public Comment:**

There were no public comments.

***Reading and Approval of Minutes:**

Minutes of the May 3, 2022 meeting were reviewed with no corrections noted. Commissioner Bower made the motion to approve the minutes as presented. Commissioner Quinn seconded the motion. Chairman Noll called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

***Commissioner Comments and Committee Reports**

Commissioner Quinn stated that she will do a better job and ask more questions when entities/organizations appear before the Board to ask for appropriations.

***New Business Before the Board:**

Keith Rickard, Guidance Center, appeared before the Board with the 2023 Budget Request. Mr. Rickard is asking for \$73,000.00 for the Guidance Center and \$29,574.00 for the Regional Crisis Center. This is not an increase from last year.

The Memorial Hall Trustees sent in a letter with their 2023 Budget Request. They are asking for \$30,000.00. This is not an increase from last year.

Stephanie Barnes, Project Concern, appeared before the Board with the 2023 Budget Request. Ms. Barnes is asking for \$125,000.00. This is not an increase from last year.

Jim Rowland, Atchison Chamber of Commerce, appeared before the Board with the 2023 Budget Requests. Mr. Rowland is asking for \$7,500.00 for the Chamber of Commerce and \$7,500.00 for Main Street. This is not an increase from last year.

Mark Zeltner, Finance Director, appeared before the Board with a letter of support to the Office of the Attorney General. This letter will go with the grant application for the Victim/Witness Coordinator position with Atchison County. Commissioner Bower made a motion to sign the letter of support. Commissioner Quinn seconded the motion. Chairman Noll called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

***County Counselor Updates:**

There were no County Counselor updates.

***Executive Session:**

Commissioner Quinn moved that the Board of County Commissioners recess into executive session at 1:50 pm to discuss personnel matters of nonelected personnel, as allowed by K.S.A. 75-4319(b) (1), and that the purpose of the closed session is to protect the privacy rights of the employee, and that the Board come out of the executive session at 2:10 pm, in the commission room, lower level, courthouse. Those present will be: the three commissioners, HR Director Jodi Moore, County Counselor Patrick Henderson, and Finance Director Mark Zeltner. Commissioner Bower seconded the motion. Chairman Noll called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0. There was no action taken.

***Public Comment:**

There were no public comments.

Add, abate, escapes for real estate and personal property taxes were presented to be approved.

Bills were presented to be signed.

Commissioner Bower made the motion to adjourn at 2:10 pm. Commissioner Quinn seconded the motion. Chairman Noll called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.
