Meeting was opened at 5:37pm by GIS Coordinator Roger Denton.

Discussion began with Roger Denton going over his Web Based Maps. Roger showed everyone how to use the maps online and what the legends mean. He talked about the base maps that show each Commissioner's districts distinguished by different colors. He went over the bridge maps which show all FAS bridges, off system bridges, new/short span bridges and KDOT bridges. He went over the culvert maps which show the location of all culverts known to exist in the county. He explained that each icon on the maps represent a road, culvert, or bridge and that by clicking on it, you can pull up details regarding that specific structure such as ownership, size, condition, and more.

Joe Snyder led the group through a PowerPoint discussion regarding the newly established Atchison County Road Policy. We talked about the importance of sharing information and being consistent throughout the County. We passed out handouts that included the Road Policy, Entrance/Culvert Applications, Development Permits, and the NEKES application and information sheet.

OPEN DISCUSSION

We answered questions and took comments regarding all of the information that had been presented. We agreed to follow up, on or after February 1, 2022, to see if any of the townships are interested in working with the Atchison County Road Policy.

Commissioner Quinn thanked everyone for coming and being willing to listen to new ideas and asked for opinions regarding the cost of the 911 address signs for new construction.
